The article is presenting the model of correlation of types of temperament, accentuated characters and main types of mental insanity of the personality. The introduced model shows the continuity of the change of different psychic conditions as well as the main correlation existing between types of temperament, accentuated characters and main types of mental insanity of the personality. During the forming the scheme of correlation of psychic conditions the new axis “emotional lability – emotional rigidity” was introduced along with “classical” axis “introversion - extraversion” and instead of second “classical” axis “neurosis - stability”. This scheme of united, integral space emotional-personal area of the human being (“personal space”) is giving the opportunity to form “psychological portrait of the personality”. The form of this portrait is very specific for each individual on a particular period of life.
