in memory of Vladimir Mikhailovich Munipov**

Known philosophers T.G. Shchedrina and B.I. Pruzhinin share their memories of meetings with Vladimir Mikhailovich Munipov and their thoughts about his personality and activities. V.M. Munipov (1931-2012) was a Doctor of Psychology, professor of ergonomics, corresponding member and then member of the Russian Academy of Education, Honored Worker of Culture of the Russian Federation. He stood at the origins of the Soviet ergonomics. V.M. Munipov taught at the Moscow State University, Moscow State Institute of Radio Engineering, Electronics and Automation, Moscow State University of Psychology and Education and other universities. Vladimir Munipov was one of the founders of the Department of Psychology of the University "Dubna", and from 2008 he was the chairman of the State Attestation Commission of this University "Dubna" 's Department. In 2012, V.M. Munipov's personal library was donated to the Department of Psychology at the University "Dubna" as a gift, as well as the Psychological center of V.M. Munipov was created at the Department of Psychology at the University "Dubna" in honor of Vladimir Mikhailovich Munipov.
